Since June this year we have started after school study classes and this has received a good response from the community. The gap between online teaching and what needs to be actually learnt is covered in the presential classes that happen every afternoon in our centre.

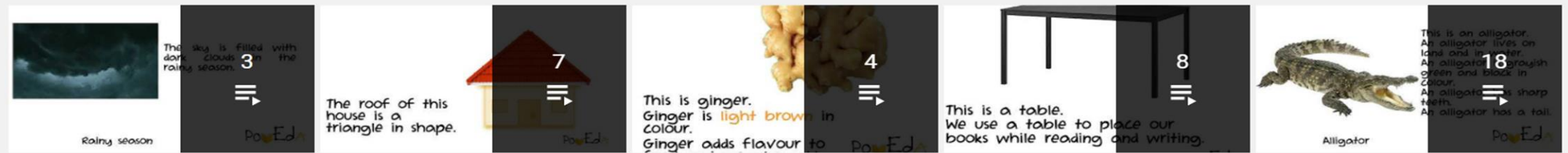

Teacher Training:

We led a workshop for 40 teachers from St. Andrew's School, Chinchwad at the start of the school year on the topic of Stress Management. The session helped the teachers look at themselves and others by understanding the 4 types of personalities, Jottari Window and learning tools of empathy and assertiveness.

Another workshop for the teachers of the after school learning classes of Idea Foundation was held in July. The teachers are supporting over 500 kids through online classes. The session dealt with different aspects of planning, writing objectives, success criteria and tools of measuring

Collaboration:

Ibtada is a non profit that works extensively across Rajasthan. They have started a 3 month online course in Spoken English that reaches out to 750 youth through a pool of 60 volunteers. We have assisted them in the development of the course curriculum and in mentoring volunteers.
