Our kids went on a picnic to the boating club in Chinchwadgaon. They had fun there on the different rides and enjoyed playing some new games organized by their didis.






The centre celebrated its Christmas party on 19<sup>th</sup> December with songs, games and many, many Christmas gifts for each child.




# Spoken English Classes in ZP Schools
